- ESS is perceived more of a black box than a white box from an engineering aspect related to
  - Standardization
  - Integration
  - Project Information management
- Its obvious that
  - ESS need to take care of all communicated concerns
  - Central teams of ESS need a direct involvement with the In-Kind partner
    - The central team offers a service to the In-Kind partners
    - Establishment of direct communication is urgent
    - Central team needs to be present/visit In Kind partners on a regular basis
- Vision sharing
  - ESS need to provide unambiguous visualization and access for In Kind
